INTRODUCTION
Introduction

On the dates of March 31, April 1, April 4, and April 7, 2016, TCEQ received sixty-two (62) complaints by telephone and e-mail regarding a strong odor in the vicinity of Shadow Creek Ranch neighborhood in Pearland, Texas. The complaints were documented in TCEQ incident #230424.

Complainants were contacted via telephone and email by Ms. Gabrielle Lamoreaux on April 5, 2016. All complainants claimed that a very strong chemical and/or garbage odor was present either in the early morning (0000-0900) or in the evening (1800-2300). This odor has allegedly occurred intermittently, usually once or twice a week. Several complainants claimed that the odor has become stronger and more frequent in the last six to twelve months. The majority of complainants believed that the source of the odor is Blue Ridge Landfill (BRL), located at 2200 Farm to Market (FM) 521 road, and/or an unspecified chemical plant. Several complainants claimed various health effects such as nausea, headaches, eye irritation, breathing irritation, while others only expressed concern for their health.

In order to identify the most probable source and to determine whether a nuisance condition existed, the investigators conducted odor logs at various points near BRL at a distance that was approximately equidistant to the complainants' locations from the alleged source. Odors were assessed for frequency, intensity, duration, and offensiveness.

An area map is in Attachement 1. Focus areas are indicated by red squares.

As a note, the TCEQ previously conducted a Site Full Compliance Investigation (SFCI) at BRL on March 21, 2016, to assess compliance with applicable air quality requirements (Investigation #1314997).

#### **Investigation Narrative**

The investigation took place on April 4 and 7, 2016. The investigation was conducted by Ms. Gabrielle Lamoreaux, Mr. Carlos Griggs, Mr. Justin Mayworn, Ms. Jessica Fox, Mr. Kevin McLeod, Mr. Corbett Brinly, and Mr. John Bregger. The surrounding land use is a mix of residential, commercial, and industrial areas. The terrain is flat with sporadic forest. #### April 4, 2016

At 9:45 a.m., investigators Ms. Lamoreaux and Mr. Griggs arrived in the Shadow Creek Ranch subdivision near the intersection of FM 2234 road and FM 521 road. The investigators surveyed the area including Crystal Cove, Edge Water, and Westhaven neighborhoods and Trinity Bay Drive, Kingsley Drive, and West Broadway Street (See attachment 3 – odor survey maps). No odors were detected. The investigators left the area at 10:45 a.m.

At 11:35 a.m, the investigators surveyed Quail Bridge and Ridgemont neighborhoods. This included Court Road, Raven Ridge Drive, and Park Manor Street (See attachment 3). No odors were detected. The investigators left the area at 12:20 p.m.

#### April 7, 2016

At 5:34 a.m., the investigators, Ms. Lamoreaux, Mr. Bregger, Mr. Brinly, Ms. Fox, Mr. McLeod, and Mr. Mayworn arrived at the alleged area in three vehicles. At this time, the investigators experienced a petroleum odor off of TX-288 and Shadow Creek Parkway. The investigators traveled west on Shadow Creek Parkway and the odor continued for a few minutes. The investigators stopped off of Shadow Creek Parkway between Trinity Bay Drive and Almeda Road for several minutes. The investigators detected a light honeysuckle odor, which was determined to be the landfill odor control. The investigators traveled west on Shadow Creek Parkway to about Sidonie Drive. No odor was detected. The investigators turned around to Almeda Road. A landfill odor similar to rotting garbage was detected at the intersection of Almeda Road and Shadow Creek Parkway.

At 5:52 a.m., the odor was still present as the investigators drove south on Almeda Road and stopped at 810 FM

521 road. The odor was a strong landfill odor. The investigators left at the site at 5:57 a.m.

At 6:00 a.m., the investigators stopped at the mercaptan station off of Almeda Road. A very light landfill odor was detected. Ms. Laurie Rodriguez, Pretreatment Coordinator for City of Pearland, arrived shortly afterwards and discussed with the investigators about incoming complaints. Mr. Matt Montagna, Landfill Operation's Manager, saw the investigators and stopped at the mercaptan station. Mr. Montagna discussed with the investigators about the odors and how the landfill was spraying an odor control substance. The investigators split into three teams and left the site at 6:20 a.m.

At 6:22 a.m., investigators Ms. Lamoreaux and Mr. Mayworn stopped on the east side of Almeda Road to conduct an odor survey (See attachment 2 – Investigators' Odor Logs). A moderate to strong landfill odor was detected, but after several minutes it became very light to light. The odor survey ended and the investigators left at 6:40 a.m.

At 6:30 a.m., investigators Mr. Brinly and Mr. Bregger detected a garbage odor at Laura Ingalls Wilder Elementary located at 2225 Kingsley Drive. The investigators returned to the school at 6:40 a.m. but did not detect any odor. They left the site at 6:50 a.m.

At 6:33 a.m., investigators Mr. McLeod and Ms. Fox conducted a one hour odor survey on Laurel Loch Lane (See attachment 2). A light to moderate landfill/ garbage odor was detected. The odor was not of sufficient frequency, intensity, duration, and offensiveness to confirm a nuisance condition. The investigators left the site at 7:37 a.m.

At 6:40 a.m., investigators Ms. Lamoreaux and Mr. Mayworn stopped at 810 FM 521 road and conducted a one hour odor survey (See attachment 2). The offensive landfill odor was moderate. Towards the end of the survey, a honeysuckle odor was detected, which was determined to be the odor control from the landfill. The investigators also collected a 30 minute summa canister sample, from 6:53 a.m. to 7:23 a.m. The investigators left the site at 7:45 a.m.

At 6:55 a.m., investigators Mr. Brinly and Mr. Bregger detected a sweet odor while driving south on Tarpon Bay Court.

At 7:03 a.m., the investigators detected a very light garbage odor at Swift Creek Drive and Beacon Springs. At 7:07 a.m., the investigators conducted a thirty minute odor survey at the intersection of Horizon View Lane and Swift Creek Drive. A very light to light garbage odor was detected. The odor was not of sufficient frequency, intensity, duration, and offensiveness to confirm a nuisance condition. The investigators left the site at 7:37 a.m.

At 7:57 a.m., investigators Ms. Lamoreaux and Mr. Mayworn detected a landfill odor at the intersection of Cambridge Bay Drive and Harborside Lane. The odor dissipated after a few minutes. The investigators left site at 8:00 a.m.

At 8:01 a.m., investigators Ms. Lamoreaux and Mr. Mayworn arrived at the end of Cayman Bend Lane. No odor was detected. The investigators left the site at 8:06 a.m.

At 8:07 a.m., investigators Ms. Lamoreaux and Mr. Mayworn arrived at Rolling Fog Drive and Fire Water Lane. A landfill odor was detected. The odor dissipated after a few minutes. The investigators left site at 8:14 a.m.

At 8:17 a.m., investigators Ms. Lamoreaux and Mr. Mayworn arrived at Trinity Bay Drive and Pebble Bay Drive. A garbage odor was detected. The odor was strong for a minute but became very light in a few minutes. The investigators left the site at 8:25 a.m.

At 8:28 a.m., investigators Ms. Lamoreaux and Mr. Mayworn joined Ms. Fox, Mr. McLeod, and Ms. Rodriguez of City of Pearland at Fountain Rock Drive and Arcadia Bay Drive. They had detected a strong chemical odor that the investigators characterized as fried onion, cabbage, burnt bread, sulfur, or garlic. The mixed odor dissipated rapidly, but was determined to be moving to the east. The investigators left the site at 8:33 a.m.

At 8:34 a.m., the investigators stopped at Shadowmere Drive and were joined by investigators Mr. Brinly and Mr. Bregger. A strong mixed fried onion/ cabbage odor was detected but faded after a few minutes. The investigators left at 8:40 a.m.

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At 8:41 a.m., the investigators detected a strong mixed fried onion/ cabbage odor and stopped on the side Trinity Bay Drive. The investigators collected a 15 second grab sample with a summa canister at 8:42 a.m. The investigators and Ms. Rodriguez left the site at 8:48 a.m.

At 8:50 a.m., the investigators and Ms. Rodriguez arrived at Village of Diamond Bay Water Park. The investigators detected a moderate garbage odor. A 15 second grab sample was collected with a summa canister at 8:52 a.m. Ms. Rodriguez received information that a landfill odor was being detected at the waste water treatment plant. Ms. Rodriguez left to the landfill to determine if they were discharging leachate. The investigators left the site at 9:05 a.m.

At 9:12 a.m., the investigators arrived at the waste water treatment plant. The investigators met with Mr. Eric Wilson, Director of Public Works, from City of Pearland and Councilman Derrick Reed. The investigators went on top of the waste water treatment facility to observe the operations and assess the odors. Faint landfill odors were detected intermittently by some investigators. Ms. Rodriguez arrived on-site and mentioned that BRL did not discharge their leachate system. The investigators left the site at 9:55 a.m.

At 10:29 a.m., investigators Ms. Lamoreaux and Mr. Mayworn detected a rotting fish/garbage odor from Kirby Drive and Spectrum Boulevard. The investigators joined Ms. Fox and Mr. McLeod near 14822 Hooper Road. Ms. Fox and Mr. McLeod left the site at 10:34 a.m. Ms. Lamoreaux and Mr. Mayworn stopped and collected a 15 second grab sample in a summa canister across the street from Syntech Chemicals and Brenntag Southwest at 10:39 a.m. Investigators left the site at 10:40 a.m.

The actual source of the garbage/trash and honeysuckle odors were determind to be BRL. During the investigation, the strongest landfill odor was a moderate offensive odor that last about one hour. A single occurrence nuisance for an offensive odor must be very strong for four hours or strong for 12 hours. Based on the Frequency, Intensity, Duration, and Offensiveness (FIDO) chart, a nuisance could not be confirmed.

The presence and concentrations of Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs) were analyzed in the 15 second grab samples. The short duration of the samples was insufficient for evaluating for potential health effects. The presence and concentrations of VOCs were also analyzed in the 30 minute sample. The VOCs were either not detected or were detected below their respective short-term air monitoring comparison values. These levels of VOCs are not expected to cause short-term adverse health effects. However, because of a leak check failure, the data may not be representative of concentrations present during sampling.

#### **Exit Interview**

An exit interview was not conducted since there were no alleged violations, additional issues, or records requested.

In addition, the complainants were contacted by phone with the results of the investigation April 11, 12, 13, and 14, 2016. Several of the complainants were anonymous and were not contacted.

#### GENERAL FACILITY AND PROCESS INFORMATION

#### **Process Description**

Blue Ridge Landfill accepts waste and has a gas collection and control system. Detailed process descriptions can be found in the Houston Region files.

#### **BACKGROUND**

Agreed Orders, Court Orders, and Other Compliance Agreements

Based on review of CCEDS and the regional office files, there were no agreed orders, court orders, or other compliance agreements for the site.

#### **Prior Enforcement Issues**

Based on a review of CCEDS and the regional office files, violations were issued by the TCEQ to the alleged source

Complaints




