# **Summary**

The National Citizen Survey™ (The NCS™) is a collaborative effort between National Research Center, Inc. (NRC) and the International City/County Management Association (ICMA). The survey and its administration are standardized to assure high quality research methods and directly comparable results across The NCS communities. This report discusses differences in opinion of survey respondents by area (North, North East, South, South East and West).

Responses in the following tables show only the proportion of respondents giving a certain answer; for example, the percent of respondents who rated the quality of life as "excellent" or "good," or the percent of respondents who attended a public meeting more than once a month. ANOVA and chi-square tests of significance were applied to these comparisons of survey questions. A "p-value" of 0.05 or less indicates that there is less than a 5% probability that differences observed between geographic areas are due to chance; or in other words, a greater than 95% probability that the differences observed are "real." Where differences were statistically significant, they have been shaded grey.

The margin of error for this report is generally no greater than plus or minus four percentage points around any given percent reported for the entire sample (733 completed surveys). For each geographic area (North, North East, South, South East and West), the margin of error rises to approximately plus or minus 15 percentage points since sample sizes were approximately 65 for the North, 64 for the North East, 63 for the South, 44 for the South East and 42 for the West. Notable differences between City subareas included the following:

- Within the pillar of Community Characteristics, respondents living in the South and West areas of the City tended to give more positive ratings to the ease of walking in Pearland and the availability of paths and walking trails than residents in other areas. Variety of housing options received lower ratings from respondents in the North East than from respondents in other City areas. Within Economy, participants from the South East tended to give somewhat lower ratings than their counterparts to the overall economic health of Pearland, while residents from the South were much more likely than residents of other areas to give excellent or good ratings to employment opportunities in Pearland. Respondents in the South of the City also awarded higher marks to opportunities to participate in religious or spiritual events and activities in Pearland than residents of other City areas.
- Respondents from the South East were less likely to give excellent or good ratings to the overall direction that the City of Pearland is taking than residents of other areas of the City. Within Mobility, residents of the North East area tended to give lower ratings to street repair, but gave significantly higher ratings to traffic signal timing than respondents from other areas of the City. Garbage collection services were given higher ratings by respondents from the North East and South areas of the City. Respondents from the South also tended to give higher ratings to land use, planning and zoning than residents from other areas. Public library services received less positive ratings from residents of the West area of the City.
- Within the pillar of Participation, residents from the North East and South gave higher ratings to the sense of community in Pearland than residents of several other areas of the City. Respondents from the West area of the City reported higher rates of walking or biking instead of driving than their counterparts in other City subareas. Residents from the North and South East regions of the City were less likely than their counterparts to work within the city limits of Pearland.
- Some interesting differences between city subareas emerged when residents were asked about the sources they use to get information about the City of Pearland. Residents in the West were more likely to say that the local government cable channel was a major or minor source of information than participants from other areas. However, respondents from the West were less likely to indicate that the City water bill insert was a source of information. Residents from the South area of Pearland were more likely than their counterparts to indicate that City communications via social media were a major or minor source of information.
- Respondents from the North East were significantly more likely to support a property tax increase to fund drainage improvements than residents from other areas of Pearland.
- The leadership provided by the City's elected officials received somewhat less positive ratings from residents of the West area of the City.
