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### **Investigation Comments:**

INTRODUCTION Introduction

On September 16, 2016, September 20, 2016, and September 26, 2016 the TCEQ Houston Region Office (TCEQ) received three (3) complaints, Incident Nos. 243914 & 244116. The complaints were received via email at approximately 12:14 AM, 9:35 AM, and 8:37 AM, respectively. The complainants alleged that there is a toxic smell in the air that is affecting quality of life for the complainant and other residents in the area. Additionally, the complaint received on September 26, 2016, alleged health effects that occurred during the incident on September 15, 2016. Therefore, these two complaints were assigned one incident no. During the incidents the meteorological conditions were as follows: approximately 81.1 and 87.25 degrees Fahrenheit; 75% & 69% relative humity; and wind direction was East Southeast and South West, respectively. The source for meteorological conditions is Weather Underground Station I.D. KTXPEARL41. On September 16, 2016, the investigators proceeded to the area.

#### Investigation Narrative

On September 16, 2016, TCEQ Investigators, Mr. Seth Tate & Ms. Nicole Foster, arrived in the area at approximately 2:50 PM. The investigators began conducting an odor survey of the area down wind of the potential source, Lone Star Recycling & Disposal (Lone Star). While conducting the odor survey, the investigators did not detect any odors. The investigators concluded the odor survey at approximately 3:30 P.M. Meteorlogical conditions during the investigation are as follows: approximately 92.19 degrees Fahrenheit, 56% relative humidity, wind direction was South East. The source for meteorlogical conditions is Weather Underground Station I.D. KTXPEARL41.

The investigators then proceded to the potential source, Lone Star. The investigators were joined by Mr. Richard Blackney, Environmental Investigator with the TCEQ's Waste Section. The investigators proceeded on site at approximately 3:50 PM and met with Mr. Jeremy King, Landfill Manager for Lone Star. The investigators proceded with Mr. King on a walkthrough of the facility. The investigators were taken to the transfer station and the working face of the facility. During the walkthrough of the working face of the landfill, it was noted that it included wood and concrete rubble. No putrescible waste, household waste, or other prohibited wastes were observed. During the walkthrough, it was noted that no odors were detected on-site. According to Mr. Blackney, Lone Star is required to apply six inches of soil to the working face weekly. Additionally, Mr. Seth Tate performed a survey using the Optical Gas Imaging Camera (OGIC) which is capable of detecting volatile organic compound (VOC) emissions that are not visible with the naked eye. During the walkthrough, no emissions were noted. The investigators then proceeded to the main office of Lone Star to review records.

Mr. Tate inquired about any air authorizations the facility is claiming. Mr. King stated that the facility does not claim any air authorizations at this facility, and Mr. Tate confirmed this in the TCEQ's Central Registry. Mr. Blackney proceeded to review information required under 30 Texas Admin. Code Chapter 330 relating to Municipal Solid Waste. This information included the following: cover logs for the previous three months, daily site inspections, and a summary of all wastes received. According to Mr. Blackney, the cover logs indicated that soil had been applied to the working face as required, the floor and tunnel of the transfer station were washed daily, and no unauthorized household or putrescible wastes were deposited at the landfill.

Once Mr. Blackney received all records requested, the investigators thanked Mr. King for his time and promptly left the facility at approximately 4:50 PM.

Facility Authorization Narrative

Since Lone Star is a Type IV landfill, no air authorizations are required for this facility.

#### Exit Interview

An exit interview was not conducted since there were no alleged violations, additional issues, or records requested.

In addition, the complainants were contacted by email with the results of the investigation on the following dates: September 21, 2016 at 4:40 PM; September 22, 2016 at 6:50 AM; and September 27, 2016 at 2:05 PM.

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#### GENERAL FACILITY AND PROCESS INFORMATION

#### **Process Description**

Lone Star is a Type IV landfill which is authorized to operate by TCEQ Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) Disposal Permit No. 2344. Lone Star is also a Type V Transfer Station authorized by MSW Processing Permit No. 40249. The landfill is authorized to accept brush, construction and demolition debris, and rubbish. Putrescible waste may not be accepted for disposal at the landfill. The transfer station may accept putrescible and non-putrescible wastes for consolidation into larger vehicles for transfer off site.

#### BACKGROUND

Agreed Orders, Court Orders, and Other Compliance Agreements

Based on review of CCEDS and the regional office files, there were no agreed orders, court orders, or other compliance agreements for the site.

#### Prior Enforcement Issues

Based on a review of CCEDS and the regional office files, violations were issued by the TCEQ to the alleged source during the past five years. There are no repeat violations.

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### Complaints

Based on a review of CCEDS during the past five years, there was one odor complaint received on March 22, 2016 and investigated by the Region 12 Office CCEDS No. 1265975. The complaint was unconfirmed.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Conclusions, Recommendations, and Current Enforcement Actions

Based on this investigation, no violations are being alleged.

#### Additional Issues

No additional issues were noted during this investigation.


