INTRODUCTION

On September 6, 8, 11, 12, 13, 14, 21, 22, 25 and 26, 2017, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) Houston Region Office Waste Section received 128 complaints alleging odors from Blue Ridge Landfill (BRL) located at 2200 FM 521 Road, Fresno (Fort Bend County), Texas 77545. The odors were alleged to have occurred on September 5, 6, 7, 9, 11, 12, 13, 21, 24 and 26, 2017.

On September 14, 2017, Mr. Richard Blackney, Environmental Investigator of the TCEQ Houston Region Office, conducted a site visit regarding hurricane debris at BRL. On September 26, 2017, Mr. Blackney and Ms. Asusena Renteria, Environmental Investigators of the TCEQ Houston Region Office, conducted an unannounced Odor Complaint Investigation at BRL and the area surrounding it.

BACKGROUND

A Notice of Enforcement was issued to BRL on October 21, 2016 for failure to prevent nuisance odor conditions. On July 12, 2017, Agreed Order Docket No. 2016-1923-AIR-E was signed by the TCEQ.

In a "Request for Approval of Temporary Debris Management Site for Debris Resulting from Declared State or Federal Disaster" signed on August 25, 2017, Republic Services requested authorization for BRL to be used as a staging and stockpiling site for debris from Hurricane Harvey.

On August 28, 2017, BRL sent a Request for Emergency Authorization to the TCEQ due to Hurricane Harvey. The letter requested extended operating hours; additional time to repair erosion and remove ponded water; increased leachate levels on the liner system; a brush grinding authorization; additional time to repair fences, markers and signs; discontinuous landfill gas collection and control system operation; a variance for the working face size; and suspension of daily cleanup of waste along site access roads. By a letter dated August 31, 2017, the TCEQ MSW Permits Section granted the emergency authorization for a period of 30 days from the date of the letter.

GENERAL FACILITY AND PROCESS INFORMATION

BRL's authorization numbers from the TCEQ Central Registry database are included in Attachment 1. BRL is a

Type I landfill which is authorized to operate by TCEQ Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) Permit No. 1505A. The surrounding land use includes industrial facilities and residential subdivisions.

The landfill is authorized to dispose of MSW including household solid waste, commercial solid waste, construction and demolition waste, and yard waste; Class 1, Class 2, and Class 3 non-hazardous industrial solid waste; and certain special wastes. Liquid waste will be accepted at the Liquid Waste Bulking Facility for stabilization and subsequent disposal. BRL may not accept regulated hazardous waste, prohibited polychlorinated biphenyls, or untreated medical waste.

Prior to Hurricane Harvey the waste acceptance hours were Monday through Friday, 4:00 am to 5:00 pm, and Saturdays from 5:30 am to 12:00 pm. However, at the time of the investigation, BRL had emergency authorization to operate 24 hours a day and seven days a week.

Some of the incidents for this complaint investigation are included in Data Maintenance File Review Nos. 1438669 and 1438670.

Description of Alleged Effects:

Breathing difficulty, sinus irritation, nausea and vomiting, headache, throat irritation, difficulty sleeping, burning of the eyes, and coughing were described as occurring due to the odors.

Summary of the September 14, 2017 on-site investigation:

On September 14, 2017, Mr. Blackney arrived at BRL and met with Mr. Matt Montagna, Landfill Operations Manager and Mr. Burgess Stengl, Environmental Manager. No storm debris was observed to be staged in the designated storm debris storage areas located to the west and north of the landfill. According to the facility representatives, their intention is to send storm debris directly to the landfill for disposal rather than to stage the debris. During the site drive-through, water was observed in the new lined cell of the landfill. The investigator observed that a berm had been built along the rim of the cell to protect the water within from runoff.

Summary of the September 26, 2017 on-site investigation:

The investigator arrived at BRL and met with Mr. Montagna and Mr. Stengl, to whom the purpose and scope of the investigation were explained.

Six inches of soil is applied to the Class 1 and MSW working faces at the end of each operating day. The investigator viewed the MSW and Class 1 working faces, by which piles of soil were observed. The investigator obtained a copy of the MSW working face cover log for September 1 to 25, 2017 (Attachment 2).

BRL has a system of misters for the purpose of neutralizing odors. The investigator viewed the misting system in operation.

Some erosion gullies were observed on the slopes of the landfill. At the time of the investigation, BRL had emergency authorization allowing for additional time to repair cover.

Small amounts of ponded water were observed on the landfill. The cover log indicated that 1.2 inches of rain had fallen on September 23, 2017. At the time of the investigation, the landfill rule requiring the elimination and regrading of areas with ponded water within seven days of the occurrence of ponding was suspended by the Office of Governor Gregg Abbott at the request of the Executive Director of the TCEQ.

Odor Survey (OS):

At 12:26 p.m., the investigators arrived at the first survey point located downwind of BRL on the 16600 block of W Ripple Ridge Drive in Houston. No odors were detected during the 15 minutes spent at OS Site No. 1.

At 12:44 p.m., the investigators arrived at the second survey point located at the intersection of Hiram Clarke Rd. and Clarke Springs Dr. in Houston. No odors were detected during the 15 minutes spent at OS Site No. 2.

At 1:11 p.m., the investigators arrived at the third survey point located on the 300 block of W Riley Road in Pearland. No odors were detected during the 15 minutes spent at OS Site No. 3.

An aerial view map of the OS locations and the OS logs are included in Attachment 3.

Odor Frequency, Intensity, Duration and Offensiveness (FIDO) Chart Evaluation:

According to the FIDO protocol, the odor of landfill garbage is characterized as "offensive". Prior to the September 26, 2017 odor survey, garbage odors from the direction of BRL were previously detected by the investigator on July 21 and August 15, 2017. Therefore, the frequency of odors documented by the investigator was a quarterly occurrence. According to FIDO protocol, a nuisance condition was not confirmed.

CONCLUSION

According to FIDO protocol, nuisance odor conditions were not confirmed during the investigation conducted on September 26, 2017.




