INTRODUCTION

Introduction

Between July 11 and July 14, 2019, seven odor complaints (six unique complainants) were received via the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) online complaint form, Houston Region's air section phone duty line or by email. These complaints are part of the ongoing investigation of various odors occurring in the Shadow Creek Ranch Subdivision and surrounding area. See CCEDS Incident number 315333 for more details on the complaints filed. The complaints were filed between July 11, 2019 and July 15, 2019.

The complainants alleged a garbage or landfill odor occurring in their homes and around the neighborhood in the early-morning or in the evening. All six of the complainants identified Blue Ridge Landfill (BRL) as the alleged source of the odor.

Meteorological conditions during the alleged incidents were as follows:

- July 11, 2019 it was approximately 77.8 degrees Fahrenheit (°F) with a wind speed of 4.8 miles per hour (mph) from 337 degrees compass;
- July 13, 2019 it was approximately 79.2°F with a wind speed of 5.1 mph from 292 degrees compass;
- July 14, 2019 it was approximately 83.7 °F with a wind speed of 5.3 mph from 326 degrees compass.
- July 15, 2019 it was approximately 85.6 °F with a wind speed of 4.0 mph from 230 degrees compass.

This information was obtained via the TCEQ Manvel Croix Park C84 (CAMS 84) monitoring station.

The complainants were contacted by phone or email on July 14, 2019, to inform them that their complaint had been assigned and will be investigated.

Investigation Narrative

July 11, 2019

TCEQ investigators, Ms. Kylea Rodrigues and Mr. Jay Evans, conducted odor surveys in the west Pearland, Texas area. The area is largely residential with numerous industrial facilities. Meteorological conditions taken from CAMS 84 at the beginning of the investigation were as follows: 83.7 °F with a wind speed of 5.3 mph from 326 degrees compass. An area map overview is provided in Attachment 1, Odor Logs for July 11, 2019 are provided in Attachment 2A, and an Odor Log Location Map documenting odor survey (OS) locations is provided in Attachment 3. Meteorological conditions in the field observed by the investigators appeared to be similar to those reported by CAMS 84.

At 6:00 a.m., the investigators arrived at 2502 Mountain Sage Road (N 29.5658, W -95.4372); (OS3). Each investigator completed a 70-minute odor survey. While conducting the odor survey, Mr. Evans experienced mild nausea. A complaint received on July 15, 2019 noted similar health effects experienced by one complainant

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beginning on July 13, 2019. A very light to strong putrefying landfill odor was detected for a total of 65 minutes. The odor is characterized as highly offensive based on experience, training, and the TCEQ Odor Complaint Procedures. The one and ten-minute weighted averages were strong, and the one-hour weighted average was moderate. The investigators attributed this odor to BRL based on the investigators' training and experience, attributes of the odor, wind direction, and presence of the same odor on the adjoining Farm Road 521 across from BRL. The investigators departed from this location at approximately 7:10 a.m. This location was downwind of BRL at the time of the survey.

At 7:37 a.m., the investigators arrived at Shadow Grove Lane (N 29.5525, W -95.4378); (OS1). Each investigator conducted a 75-minute odor survey. A very light to moderate putrefying landfill odor was detected for a total of 27 minutes. The one-minute weighted average was moderate, the ten-minute weighted average was light, and the one-hour weighted average was very light. The investigators departed from this location at approximately 8:52 a.m. This location was downwind of BRL at the time of the survey.

At 9:20 a.m., the investigators arrived at 2812 Silhouette Bay Drive (N 29.5589, W -95.4245); (OS2). Each investigator conducted a 1-hour odor survey. No odors were detected. The investigators departed from this location at approximately 10:20 a.m.

At 10:27 a.m., the investigators arrived at 2034 Trinity Bay Drive (N 29.5760, W -95.4261); (OS4). Each investigator conducted a 1-hour odor survey. No odors were detected. The investigators departed from this location at approximately 11:27 a.m.

At 11:35 a.m., the investigators arrived at 7003 McHard Road (N 29.5832, W -95.4612); (OS5). Each investigator conducted a 1-hour odor survey. No odors were detected. The investigators departed from this location at approximately 12:35 p.m. This location was upwind of BRL at the time of the survey.

At 12:50 p.m., the investigators arrived at the BRL facility to gather additional information regarding the observed odors. At the time of arrival, the investigators were informed that no environmental staff were working at the facility that day. However, it was noted that the facility operations manager would be available within the next hour. The investigators waited in a facility conference room for approximately one hour.

Mr. Zachary Pedersen, the Operations Manager at the BRL facility, arrived at approximately 1:50 p.m. Mr. Pederson stated that the facility had not received any complaints that day and that all control systems were working properly that day. Mr. Pederson also stated that the odors from the landfill were caused by existing meteorological conditions at that time. Additionally, he provided the locations of where the facility had been conducting operations at that time, the working face and the Class I area (see Attachment 3 for additional information).

July 14, 2019

TCEQ investigators Ms. Kylea Rodrigues and Mr. Jay Evans conducted odor surveys in the west Pearland, Texas area. All odor logs are provided in Attachment 2. Meteorological conditions taken from CAMS 84 at the beginning of the investigation were as follows: 78.4 °F with a wind speed of 2.8 mph from 284 degrees compass. An area map overview is provided in Attachment 1, Odor Logs for July 14, 2019 are provided in Attachment 2B, and an Odor Log Location Map is provided in Attachment 3. Meteorological conditions in the field observed by the investigators appeared to be similar to those reported by CAMS 84.

At 6:05 a.m., the investigators arrived at 13502 White Cloud Court (N 29.5725, W -95.4296); (OS3). Each investigator completed a one-hour odor survey. A very light to strong putrefying landfill odor was detected for a total of 31 minutes. The one-minute weighted average was strong, the ten-minute weighted average was moderate, and the one-hour weighted average was very light. The investigators attributed this odor to BRL based on the investigators' training and experience, attributes of the odor, wind direction, and presence of the same odor on the adjoining Farm Road 521 across from BRL. The investigators departed from this location at approximately 7:05 a.m. This location was downwind of BRL at the time of the survey.

At 7:10 a.m., Ms. Rodrigues arrived at 13109 Shadow Falls Lane (N 29.5693, W -95.4189); (OS2). The investigator conducted a one-hour odor survey. No odors were detected. The investigator departed from this location at approximately 8:10 a.m.

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At 7:22 a.m., Mr. Evans arrived at Evergreen Street (N 29.5471, W -95.4690); (OS5). The investigator conducted a 1-hour odor survey. No odors were detected other than an outdoor burning smell for a total of 3 minutes. The investigator departed from this location at approximately 8:22 a.m.

At 8:21 a.m., Ms. Rodrigues arrived at Shadow Grove Lane (N 29.5525, W -95.4378); (OS1). The investigator conducted a one-hour odor survey. No odors were detected. The investigator departed from this location at approximately 9:21 a.m.

At 8:40 a.m., Mr. Evans arrived at 2034 Trinity Bay Drive (29.5754, W -95.4264); (OS4). The investigator conducted a 1-hour odor survey. No odors were detected. The investigators departed from this location at approximately 9:40 a.m.

According to TCEQ Odor Complaint Investigation Procedures, frequency is the number of times that an odor has been complained about and documented to have occurred (either directly or circumstantially) by the investigator. TCEQ Odor Complaint Investigation Procedures define a weekly frequency category as having been documented during an investigator's odor survey at least three times at the complainant's site or equal distance in any 30-day period. During the 30-day period between June 15, 2019 and July 15, 2019 TCEQ staff documented odors attributed to BRL the following three times at offsite locations: July 8, 2019 in complaint investigation number 1579097, and during this investigation conducted July 11, 2019 and July 14, 2019. Based on these occurrences, the frequency of odors documented by TCEQ staff as of July 14, 2019 can be categorized as a weekly occurrence. Based on the investigators' experience and training, the odor detected at odor survey location OS3 respective to July 11, 2019 and July 14, 2019 was characterized as highly offensive.

At a weekly frequency, a highly offensive odor documented at a strong intensity for at least 1 minute constitutes a nuisance according to the TCEQ Odor Complaint Investigation procedures and the FIDO (Frequency, Intensity, Duration and Odor) chart. On July 11, 2019, TCEQ investigators conducted odor surveys at off-site locations and detected strong putrefying landfill odors, which were characterized as putrid and rancid and were categorized as highly offensive at a weighted average of 10 minutes. Additionally, during a complaint investigation conducted on July 14, 2019, TCEQ investigators conducted odor surveys at off-site locations and detected moderate putrefying landfill odors, which were characterized as putrid and rancid and were categorized as highly offensive at a weighted average of 10 minutes. In addition, on July 14, 2019, strong putrefying landfill odors, which were characterized as putrid and rancid and were categorized as highly offensive at a weighted average of 1 minute. Additionally, the investigator experienced health effects, including nausea, that was attributed to BRL odors on July 11, 2019. A violation will be issued for failure to prevent a nuisance condition under 30 TAC 101.4. For more information, see VTN 722405.

Facility Authorization Narrative

BRL operates under Federal Operating Permit O-01472.

Exit Interview

On September 17, 2019, the investigator sent Mr. Tim Telepak, Environmental Manager of BRL, an exit interview form via email. The complainants were notified of the results of the investigation on September 18, 2019.

GENERAL FACILITY AND PROCESS INFORMATION

Process Description

BRL is a municipal solid waste landfill. More detailed process descriptions can be found in the TCEQ Central File Room.

Failure to prevent a nuisance condition.

During a complaint investigation conducted on July 11, 2019, TCEQ investigators conducted odor surveys at off-site locations and detected strong putrefying landfill odors, which were characterized as putrid and rancid and were categorized as highly offensive at a weighted average of 10 minutes. Additionally, during a complaint investigation conducted on July 14, 2019, TCEQ investigators conducted odor surveys at off-site locations and detected moderate putrefying landfill odors, which were characterized as putrid and rancid and were categorized as highly offensive at a weighted average of 10 minutes. In addition on July 14, 2019, strong putrefying landfill odors, which were characterized as putrid and rancid and were categorized as highly offensive at a weighted average of 1 minute. During a 30-day period TCEQ staff documented odors from Blue Ridge Landfill (BRL) at off-site locations the following three times: July 8, 2019 in complaint investigation number 1579097; and during this investigation (1579487) conducted on July 11, 2019 and July 14, 2019. Based on these occurrences, the

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frequency of odors documented by TCEQ staff as of July 14, 2019 can be categorized as a weekly occurrence. At a weekly frequency, a highly offensive odor documented at a strong intensity for at least 1 minute constitutes a nuisance.

Additionally, on July 11, 2019, an investigator experienced mild nausea due to the strong highly offensive odors detected during the complaint investigation, similar physical health effects were reported by one complainant. The nuisance odors from BRL were determined to be injurious to or adversely affect human health, welfare, and interfered with the normal use and enjoyment of animal life, vegetation, or property.

This constitutes a violation of 30 TAC 101.4, which states, "No person shall discharge from any source whatsoever one or more air contaminants or combinations thereof, in such concentration and of such duration as are or may tend to be injurious to or to adversely affect human health or welfare, animal life, vegetation, or property, or as to interfere with the normal use and enjoyment of animal life, vegetation, or property."







On July 11, 2019 and July 14, 2019, Mr. Andrew Evans of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) Houston Region Office conducted an investigation of the above-referenced regulated entity to evaluate compliance with applicable requirements for *air quality*. Failure to prevent a nuisance condition.

During a complaint investigation conducted on July 11, 2019, TCEQ investigators conducted odor surveys at off-site locations and detected strong putrefying landfill odors, which were characterized as putrid and rancid and were categorized as highly offensive at a weighted average of 10 minutes. Additionally, during a complaint investigation conducted on July 14. 2019, TCEQ investigators conducted odor surveys at off-site locations and detected moderate putrefying landfill odors, which were characterized as putrid and rancid and were categorized as highly offensive at a weighted average of 10 minutes. In addition on July 14, 2019, strong putrefying landfill odors, which were characterized as putrid and rancid and were categorized as highly offensive at a weighted average of 1 minute. During a 30-day period TCEQ staff documented odors from Blue Ridge Landfill (BRL) at off-site locations the following three times: July 8, 2019 in complaint investigation number 1579097; and during this investigation (1579487) conducted on July 11, 2019 and July 14, 2019. Based on these occurrences, the frequency of odors documented by TCEQ staff as of July 14, 2019 can be categorized as a weekly occurrence. At a weekly frequency, a highly offensive odor documented at a strong intensity for at least 1 minute constitutes a nuisance.

Additionally, on July 11, 2019, an investigator experienced mild nausea due to the strong highly offensive odors detected during the complaint investigation, similar physical health effects were reported by one complainant. The nuisance odors from BRL were determined to be injurious to or adversely affect human health, welfare, and interfered with the normal use and enjoyment of animal life, vegetation, or property.

This constitutes a violation of 30 TAC 101.4, which states, "No person shall discharge from any source whatsoever one or more air contaminants or combinations thereof, in such concentration and of such duration as are or may tend to be injurious to or to adversely affect human health or welfare, animal life, vegetation, or property, or as to interfere with the normal use and enjoyment of animal life, vegetation, or property."

This further constitutes a violation of the following: Texas Health & Safety Code 382.085(a) and Texas Health & Safety Code 382.085(b).
