INTRODUCTION/ INVESTIGATION SUMMARY

Introduction

This investigation covered the Blue Ridge Landfill (BRL) of the Blue Ridge Landfill TX, LP, Fresno in Fort Bend County, operating under Title V Permit O-01472, initially issued on December 4, 2000, and last renewed on March 3, 2016. The purpose of the investigation was to review deviations reported under the Title V program (30 TAC 122) and determine compliance with applicable requirements.

Daily Narrative

GENERAL FACILITY AND PROCESS INFORMATION

Process Description

BRL is a landfill waste disposal facility. The area fill method involves placing waste on the ground surface or landfill liner, spreading it in layers, compacting with heavy equipment, and covering with soil. A gas extraction system collects LFG for sale and excess LFG is transferred to a flare for disposal by combustion. Leachate produced by the waste is collected and disposed of offsite. More detailed process descriptions can be found in the regional office files.
