INTRODUCTION/ INVESTIGATION SUMMARY

Introduction

On April 17, 2018, investigators Mr. William Austin Jorn and Mr. Cameron Dews of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) Houston Region Office conducted a focused odor survey investigation (Investigation Typecode FI AIR ODOR) in the city of Pearland, and in Fort Bend, Brazoria, and Harris counties in the west Pearland area. The purpose of this investigation was to conduct odor surveys to determine if odors were present in the area and identify potential sources.

Investigation Narrative

The investigation took place on April 17, 2018. The surrounding land use is a mix of residential, industrial, and commercial areas. The terrain is flat with sporadic vegetation. Meteorological conditions at 5:00 a.m. were as follows: Cloud Cover: Clear; Temperature: 58.1° Fahrenheit; Wind Direction: south-southwest (195 degrees); Wind Speed: Approximately 3.8 miles per hour (mph); Precipitation: 0.0 inches; Source of Meteorological Conditions: Manvel Croix Park C84 CAMS Station.

The investigators arrived at FM 2234 (McHard Road) at 5:25 a.m. and surveyed the northeastern side of the Blue Ridge Landfill (See Attachment 1 – Map). Winds were from south-southwest (195 degrees) at approximately 3.8 mph measured using the Manvel Croix Park C84 CAMS Station. The investigators conducted a 15-minute odor survey (See Attachment 2 – Pages 1 and 13). The investigators detected very light to light landfill garbage odors. The investigators left the area at 5:45 a.m.

The investigators arrived at Bluebonnet Drive at 5:53 a.m. and surveyed the northern side of Akzo Nobel Surface Chemistry (See Attachment 1 – Map). Winds were from south-southwest (199 degrees) at approximately 4.2 mph using the Manvel Croix Park C84 CAMS Station. The investigators conducted a 15-minute odor survey (See Attachment 2 – Pages 3 and 15). No odors were detected. The investigators left the area at 6:11 a.m.

The investigators arrived at Miramichi Court at 6:24 a.m. and surveyed the northern side of the Lone Star Disposal and Recycling facility (See Attachment 1 – Map). Winds were from south-southwest (199 degrees) at approximately 4.2 mph using the Manvel Croix Park C84 CAMS Station. The investigators conducted a 15-minute odor survey (See Attachment 2 – Pages 5 and 17). No odors were detected. The investigators left at 6:44 a.m.

The investigators arrived at Reflection Bay Wastewater Treatment Plant at 6:53 a.m. and surveyed the eastern side of the plant (See Attachment 1 – Map). Winds were from south-southwest (203 degrees) at approximately 6.5 mph using the Manvel Croix Park C84 CAMS Station. The investigators conducted a 15-minute odor survey (See Attachment 2 – Pages 7 and 19). No odors were detected. The investigators left the site at 7:11 a.m.

The investigators arrived at West Riley Road at 7:20 a.m. and surveyed the northern side of Syntech Chemicals and Brenntag Southwest (See Attachment 1 – Map). Winds were from south-southwest (203 degrees) at approximately 6.5 mph using the Manvel Croix Park C84 CAMS Station. The investigators conducted a 15-minute odor survey (See Attachment 2 – Pages 9 and 21). No odors were detected. The investigators left at 7:38 a.m.

The investigators arrived at the sewer lift station off Biscayne Bay Drive at 7:55 a.m. and surveyed the northern corner of the lift station (See Attachment 1 – Map). Winds were from the south-southwest (204 degrees) at approximately 11.9 mph using the Manvel Croix Park C84 CAMS Station. The investigators conducted a 15-minute odor survey (See Attachment 2 – Pages 11 and 23). No odors were detected. The odor surveys concluded at 8:10 a.m., and investigators left the area at 8:12 a.m.

Investigators arrived at the Blue Ridge Landfill Facility at 9:15 a.m. The facility representative present during the

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investigation were Mr. Chance Seely, Environmental Specialist and Mr. Burgess Stengl, Environmental Manager. The investigators explained the purpose, scope, and procedures of the investigation. Mr. Seely informed investigators the landfill opened at 4:00 a.m. that morning, erosion control was working, and there had been no operational changes at the landfill. He also informed investigators the vapor odor control system was operating and there had been no outages or upsets to the flares within the past 24 hours. The investigators, accompanied by Mr. Seely and Mr. Stengl, then began a tour of the landfill operations at 9:40 a.m. Mr. Dew utilized the Optical Gas Imaging Camera (OGIC) to survey operations for potential volatile organic compound (VOC) emissions.

The driving tour of the landfill began at the Phase 3 area. The working face of the landfill was active during the tour. The investigators observed garbage being transfer into the working face and covered with dirt. Two portable deodorizers were being utilized next to the working face area. Mr. Dews viewed two gas wells (W3-99 and W3-135) with the OGIC near the working face. No emissions were observed. Investigators did not observe Phase 3 cover integrity compromised in any areas during the driving tour.

The tour ended with viewing the two flares (ground and candlestick), leachate tanks, and leachate collection system with the OGIC. There were no fugitive emissions observed.

The investigators departed the facility at 10:30 am.

Exit Interview

As no violations were alleged an exit interview was not conducted.

GENERAL FACILITY AND PROCESS INFORMATION

Process Description

Blue Ridge Landfill is a municipal solid waste landfill with a landfill gas collection and control system.

Based on a review of CCEDS, regional office files, and the enforcement database, the following Agreed Orders (AO) pertaining to violations of air quality regulations were issued by the TCEQ within the past 5 years:

Prior Enforcement Issues

Based on a review of CCEDS and the regional office files, violations were issued by the TCEQ to the alleged source during the past five years. There are no repeat violations.

Complaints

Based on a review of CCEDS and regional office files, there have been hundreds of odor complaints received from within the survey area and numerous investigations related to odors. At the time of the review, multiple related investigations were being conducted by the Region 12 Office.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Conclusions, Recommendations, and Current Enforcement Actions

One distinct odor was detected throughout the investigation. The Frequency, Intensity, Duration and Offensiveness (FIDO) chart categorizes the landfill garbage odor as offensive. In order to constitute a nuisance, an offensive odor has to last more than four hours with a very strong intensity on a single occurrence. The investigators documented an offensive odor at light intensity for two minutes and very light intensity for 10 minutes.

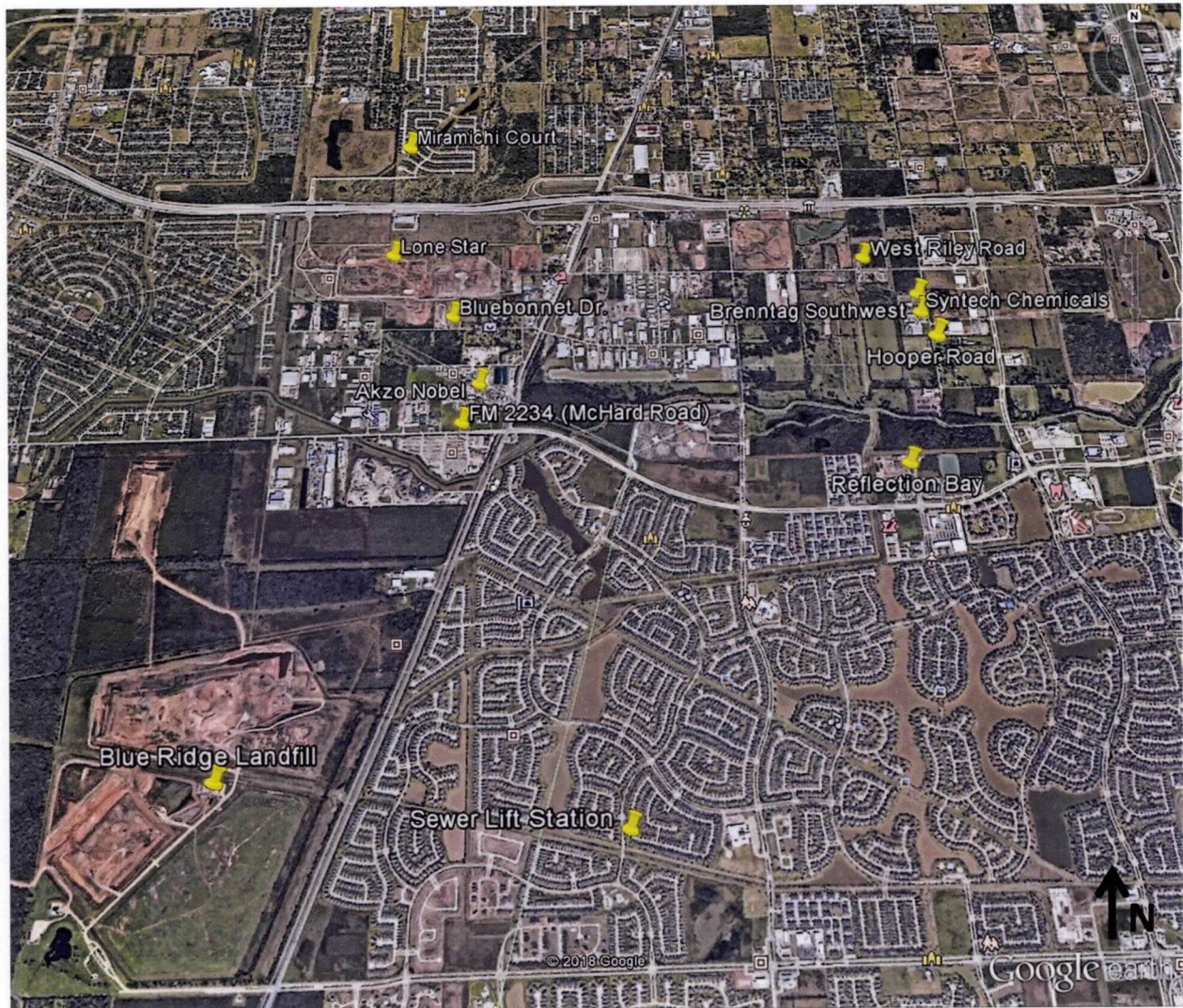
