Scope: Installation of 18" gravity sewer on Hatfield Rd; replacement and relocation of the Orange-Mykawa Lift Station with installation of a 12" gravity sewer line along Mykawa from Orange to Walnut for approximately 3,400 If and 8" force main from Mykawa west 2500 If to Hatfield Rd; abandonment of Shank Street Lift Station; replacement and relocation of Mykawa-Scott Lift Station, installation of new 8-inch force main for approximately 2,500 If from Mykawa to SH35, and new 8-12-inch gravity line approximately 3,450 If along Mykawa from Scott to Shank. Project will be coordinated with Mykawa Road construction.

Justification: Orange-Mykawa Lift Station will require a major rehabilitation within the next five years and is poorly located for servicing the area. This project will eliminate an existing inverted siphon in a gravity line and relocate the Orange-Mykawa Lift Station. In addition, the project will eliminate the Shank Street Lift Station and relocate the Scott Street Lift Station presently in conflict with the future Mykawa Road Widening.

- Staff has received the 90% engineering design, a Technical Review Committee meeting has been scheduled for February 21st, 2018
- The previously proposed design for the 6" force main has been upsized to an 8" force main for additional future capacity.
- Easements surveys have been completed. Pre-Contact letters were mailed on January 30th, and a public meeting was held on February 6th, 2018 at Hillhouse. Affected property owners were specifically invited; none of the invited property owners attended the meeting. Following this meeting we moved forward with delivering offers letters, and we expect to receive responses within the next 3 weeks.
