SH288 Northbound Frontage Road (CR59 to FM 518)

Scope: Construct a 3-lane concrete curb and gutter "urban" cross-section frontage road from County Road 59 to FM 518 (Broadway), northbound only, to include a U-turn lane under the CR59 Overpass, to include an access lane to

SH288 main lanes. Project includes right of way acquisition for detention pond. This project will include extension of City utilities under a separate project to be defined at a later date.

Justification: Current traffic routes from the Silver Lake and Southfork and areas to the south must travel through these subdivisions along Smith Ranch (CR94) to access these locations and 288 main lanes. Additionally, the frontage road would open up prime commercial frontage along SH288 between CR59 and Broadway to development and will reduce traffic on Broadway. The City is working with Brazoria County to accelerate the project by adding the project to the SH288 Toll Lane project. This will take



advantage of the bid prices for the larger toll lane project resulting in a significant savings and time savings. The City will fund the design and the County will share the construction costs with the City. This will accelerate the project by approximately 6 years with a target completion date of late 2020.

Highlights:

Staff submitted a revised Schematic Design and answers to original comments to TxDOT on August 9, 2018 for review and final approval; pending. On September 24, 2018 Council approved the Advanced Funding Agreement (AFA) with TxDOT for the project. 60% plans are due at the end of this week. Projected schedule currently maintained.

Upcoming Work Items:

- Per TxDOT requirements we are working to update the existing noise analysis conducted in April 2013 to
 include the frontage road. Berg-Oliver has been issued a contract to provide the Traffic Noise Technical
 Report update.
- Staff has finalized and submitted to TxDOT the SH288 Northbound Frontage Road Justification Report on September 28, 2018.
- TxDOT has informed the City that the original wetlands jurisdictional determination letter issued by the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) has expired. This letter determined that there we no jurisdictional wetlands within the limits of the frontage road project. This determination precluded the need for any wetlands permitting. We are working with TxDOT to request an extension of the jurisdictional determination letter from the Corps. If the letter is not extended, we may be subject to a new determination and permitting requirements if jurisdictional wetlands are found.
- Upon completion of all Environmental requirements and with a final TxDOT clearance, final costs will be
 determined and submitted to Council for approval. Subsequently and in accordance with the approved
 Interlocal Agreement, the Brazoria County Toll Road Authority will issue a Change Order to the contractor to
 initiate construction.
- TxDOT has indicated that an additional AFA between TxDOT and Brazoria County will be required to add the project to the Toll Lane project. TxDOT is preparing the agreement and Brazoria County has indicated they have no objections to an additional agreement, pending review of the agreement language.
