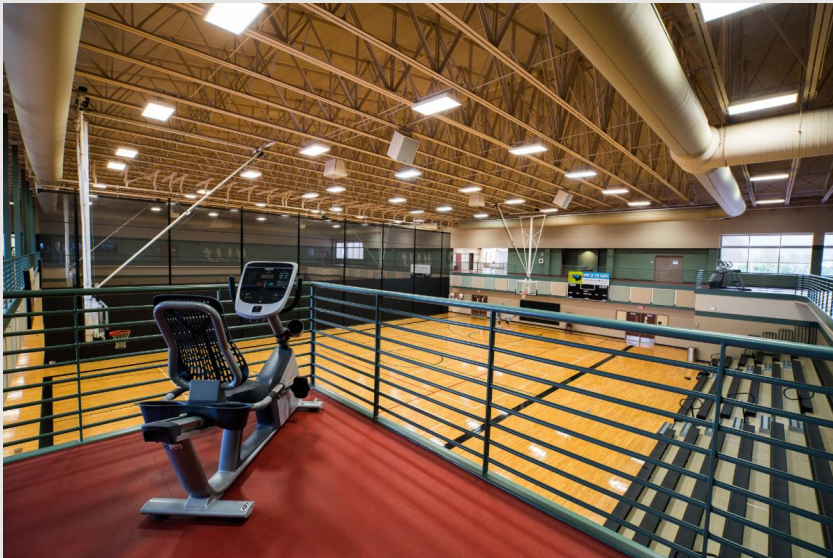

## Natatorium Deck Update

Following the installation of the new pool deck, we have identified areas that do not meet our safety standards, causing potential slip hazards and putting our members, guests and staff at risk of injury. Pearland Parks & Recreation is dedicated to maintaining high quality facilities, and even more committed to the safety of our patrons. City staff has been working closely with the installer to mitigate these safety concerns. To resurface identified slip hazards, the Natatorium will be closed as follows:

Saturday - February 8th - Natatorium closes at noon

Sunday - February 9th - Natatorium Closed

Monday - February 10th - Natatorium Closed

Tuesday - February 11th - Normal Operating Hours

## Camp Registration

### Camp KIA (Kids in Action)

Cost: \$155 resident/ \$193.75 non-resident

Age: 6 to 10 years

Location: Pearland Recreation Center & Natatorium, 4141 Bailey Road

Let your kids experience the active, carefree, safe and supportive summer experience every child desires. Camp KIA (Kids In Action) is designed for kids who are seeking a well-rounded camp experience. We offer a safe, supportive environment where campers feel comfortable trying new activities and building new skills. Each camper should bring a sack lunch and two snacks each day to camp. Camp KIA is designed for children that are entering grades 1 - 5. Each camp session will include one field trip, scheduled on Wednesdays, and two pool days, scheduled each Tuesday afternoon and Friday morning at the Natatorium. This program is not licensed by the state; however, it does follow Standards of Care.



### Camp Mahalo

Cost: \$160 resident/ \$200 non-resident

Age: 11 - 14 years

Location: Pearland Recreation Center & Natatorium, 4141 Bailey Road

In Camp Mahalo, participants will develop skills that last a lifetime, build confidence in their own skills and abilities, and enhance their motivation to make things happen. Participants will also have fun socializing with peers while learning how to be a better leader! Camp Mahalo is designed for children that are entering grades 6 - 9. Each camp session will include one field trip scheduled on Thursdays, and two-pool day scheduled each Wednesday afternoon and Friday morning at the Natatorium. This program is not licensed by the state; however, it does follow Standards of Care.
