



Want to have a food truck?

All food trucks operating in the City of Pearland must have a valid medallion from the City of Pearland Health Department.

What are the different scenarios where a food truck would be allowed?

- 1) A small private event on HOA or residential property that will **not** include sales to the public
 - In this situation a temporary event permit is not needed for the event. All that is required is that the food truck have a valid medallion from the City of Pearland Health Department.
- 2) Having a food truck on non-residential property
 - To have a food truck at an event on non-residential property a temporary event permit is required. For more information about the temporary event permit process click [here](#). To apply for a temporary event permit, click [here](#).
 - Exceptions to temporary event permits – licensed food trucks are allowed to operate at the following non-residential business types without a temporary event permit; micro-brewery, micro-distillery, or micro-winery as defined in UDC Sec. 2.5.3.2(a).
- 3) Established food trucks parks
 - Food trucks that have a valid medallion from the City of Pearland Health Department may operate at established food truck parks.
- 4) City parks or events
 - Food trucks are allowed at city parks/events with approval from the City of Pearland Parks Department and a valid medallion from the City of Pearland Health Department.
