## Ambulance Transport Guide

The Pearland Fire Department (PFD) provides a proficient and progressive approach to emergency response. In order to do this, PFD needs your help with our comprehensive community approach to emergency ambulance response. In an “Emergency” response all medical facilities should call 911 to request a PFD ambulance. When a “Non-Emergency” response or transfer is requested, medical facilities should contact a private ambulance service. Please remember, private ambulance services that pick-up or drop-off patients within the city limits *must* have a permit.

### Emergency Response

**Call 911**

Chest pain, Stroke, Unconscious, CPR, Altered mental status, Respiratory distress, Falls, Traumatic injury, etc.  
(excluding direct admits)

### Non-Emergency Response

**Call Ambulance Transport Service**

Direct admit, Abnormal lab values, Appointments, Imaging trips, Dialysis, G-tube placement, etc.
