Supplemental Online Survey Results

2015



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About this Report

As part of its participation in The National Citizen SurveyTM, the City of Pearland conducted a mailed survey of 1,200 residents. Surveys were mailed to randomly selected households on January 6th, 2015 and data were collected through February 17th, 2015. After the official data collection period was over and the data were reported (see the report, *The National Citizen Survey: Community Livability Report, Pearland, TX, 2015*), the City made available a web-based survey to its residents through a link on the City's website. Visitors to the site were able to complete the survey between February 18th and March 16th, 2015 and 186 surveys were received.

This report contains the results of this administration of the web-based survey and have not been weighted to current population estimates of Pearland.
