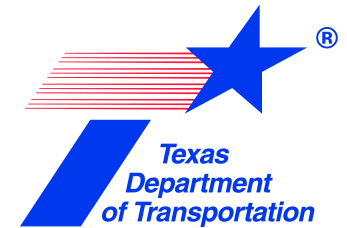

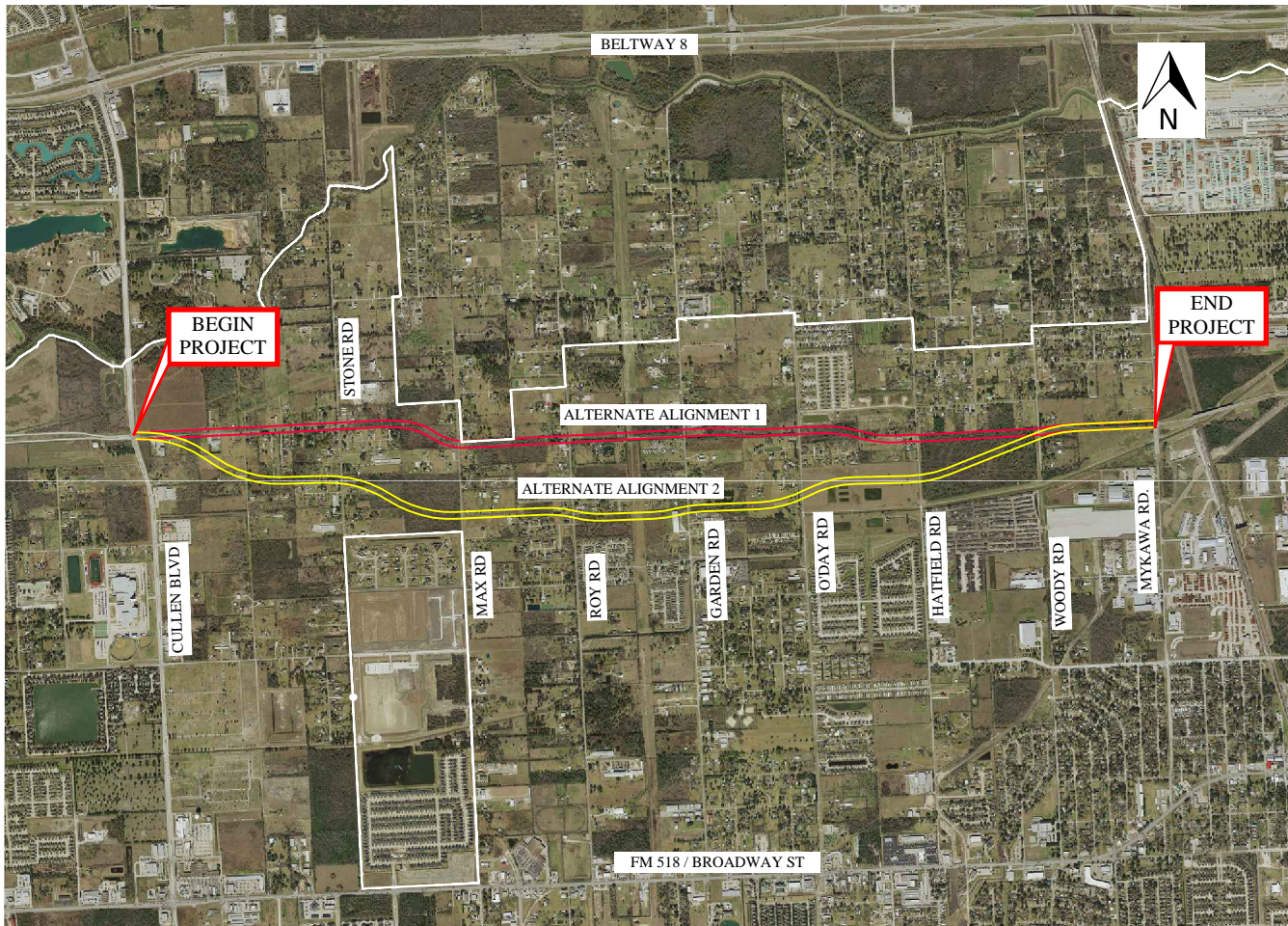
McHARD ROAD EXTENSION FROM CULLEN BOULEVARD TO MYKAWA ROAD



THE PROJECT IS ADDRESSING PUBLIC NEEDS

- MAJOR THOROUGHFARE TO PROVIDE A NEW EAST-WEST TRAVEL ALTERNATIVE, AND COMPLETE McHARD ROAD CORRIDOR FROM PEARLAND PARKWAY TO SH 288.
- ALLEVIATE CIRCULATION OF TRAFFIC CURRENTLY SATURATING FM 518 / BROADWAY STREET.
- LINK MAJOR ACTIVITIES AND EMPLOYMENT CENTERS IN THE CITY OF PEARLAND.
- PROVIDE PEARLAND RESIDENTS WITH INCREASED CONNECTIVITY TO LOCAL ROADS, AND THE REGIONAL HIGHWAY SYSTEM.
- EXPAND EVACUATION ROUTE OPTIONS.
- IMPROVE EMERGENCY VEHICLE RESPONSE TIME.
- IMPROVE MOBILITY.

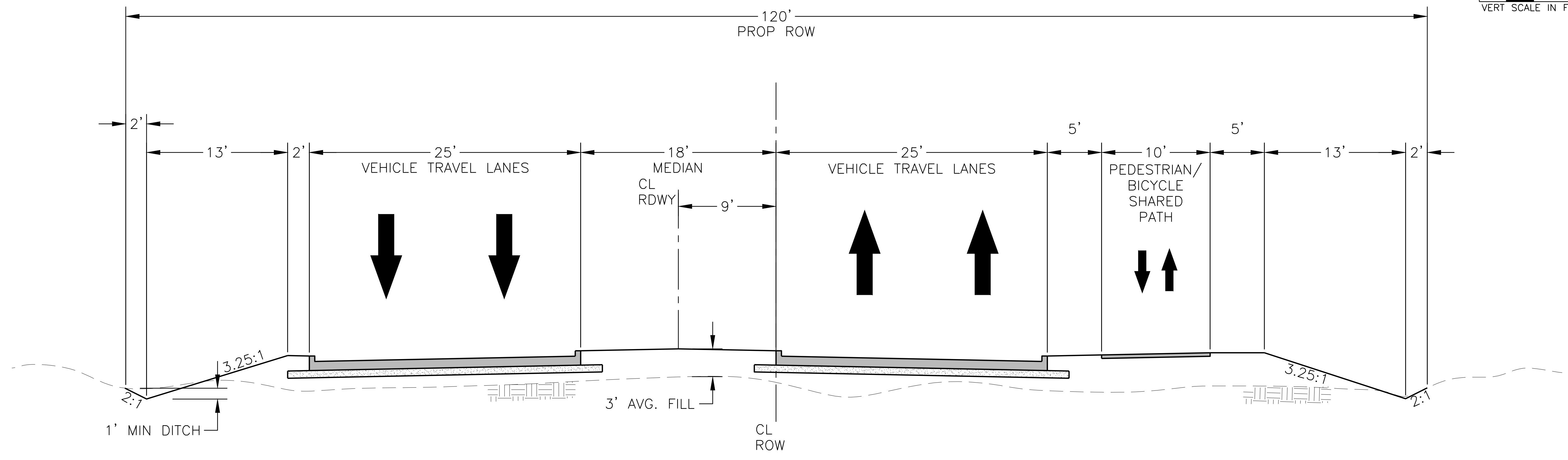


PROJECT DESCRIPTION

- PROJECT LENGTH OF APPROXIMATELY 3.5 MILES.
- MAJOR THOROUGHFARE INCLUDED IN THE CITY OF PEARLAND THOROUGHFARE PLAN.
- MEDIAN-DIVIDED ROADWAY WITH A MAXIMUM OF 2 THROUGH LANES AND LEFT-TURN BAYS IN EACH DIRECTION.
- A 10-FOOT PEDESTRIAN & BICYCLE SHARED-USE PATH ALONG THE SOUTH SIDE, FOR THE LENGTH OF THE CORRIDOR.
- STREET LIGHTS PROVIDED FOR THE ENTIRE LENGTH OF THE CORRIDOR.
- AN UNDERGROUND DRAINAGE SYSTEM WITH SWALES.
- DETENTION PONDS TO PROVIDE STORM WATER MANAGEMENT.
- McHARD ROAD WILL HAVE SIGNALIZED INTERSECTIONS, AS WARRANTED.
- ROADWAY DESIGN SPEED IS 40 mph.
- CORRIDOR-WIDE LANDSCAPING.
